Hello all Sooke families!

We are excited to start our 2025-2026 school year next week! Welcome new and returning families!

First Day - Tuesday, September 2

This first day for returning students in grades 1-5 is a shortened day and will run from 8:50 am to 11:38 am.

We ask that students please return to last year's line-up location on Tuesday Sept 2nd when the bell goes at 8:48 am. Students will return to their last year's class for the first few days until enrolment numbers are finalized across the district and schools are given permission to move students.

The following classes will be greeted by different teachers:

Division 6 (Ms. Doyle) will be met by Ms. Moore & Ms. Gates Division 13 (Ms. Froese) will be met by Mrs. Riddell

For our **new students and families**, please meet at the picnic tables/red bench by the primary playground at 8:50 am. From there the students will be escorted into the gym before moving into classes with grade level peers. Students will return to the picnic table area for pick-up Tuesday only. On Wednesday, students can line up with the class that they join on Tuesday. Please ensure you chat with your child about where they line up on Wednesday morning.

First Week

For this first week, teachers have planned a variety of learning experiences to transition students back into the classroom and create a sense of community and belonging as well as to provide students with skills and understanding to help them have a successful school year. We will work to ensure we have class placements finalized this week and then help students transition to their new classes. The exact date is yet to be determined. Please know that our staff are very thoughtful in determining class placements for each student.

Kindergarten Gradual Entry

A reminder that kindergarten is a gradual entry with shortened days beginning **Friday, September 5**th, Monday, September 8th, and Tuesday, September 9th. The first full day of kindergarten is Wednesday, September 10th. Parents of students in kindergarten please refer to the letter emailed to you in July and then again today for your family's specific time.

Our Kindergarten classes will be determined after we meet the students and get to know them. The entire Kindergarten team will work with the children during the first couple weeks of September and the students will do activities in all the Kindergarten classrooms. This will allow us to form balanced classes that support all students.

School Supplies

We are pleased to share that we have secured funds to cover school supplies for this year (2025-2026), so families will not need to purchase items. While this may not be possible in future years, we're happy to offer it for the upcoming school year.

Flourish Food for Schools

All schools in BC are now supported by the Feeding Futures School Program Fund, designed to assist schools in the development and enhancement of school meal programs and other nutritional supports for students. The goal of Feeding Futures is to support students by providing nutritious meals in an inclusive manner, to ensure that hunger is not a barrier to learning.

This school year, our school will be receiving regular support to provide snacks and hot lunches to all students who may need some food at school. Our goal is to provide food openly, in a caring and supportive manner. If you were part of this program last year, we will automatically include you in the program this year. A consent form will be sent home next week. The program won't be up and running until Monday, September 8th so please send your child/ren with a lunch next week.

Starting on Monday, September 8th, Sooke Elementary will also be offering an option for families to purchase a daily hot lunch for their student(s). The hot lunches provided by Flourish! School Food Society includes a hot entree, salad, and occasional dessert. This hot lunch is served daily during lunch time by our school meal coordinator.

The cost of this hot lunch program is \$7.00 per day, which is paid monthly as a single payment via School Cash Online. Please note, there are no refunds if a student is absent or misses lunch for other reasons.
